

AUTH Management and Working Group of the project

The **Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH)** is today the largest university in Greece with about 42.000 "active" students. There are 10 faculties, consisting of 44 departments, 5 independent departments. Research is developed in all fields of theoretical and applied science by all the schools and laboratories of the AUTH. All the research is supported by private, public and European institutions with funding. It's worth mentioning that AUTH, in the last three-year-period, has collaborated with 1.700 partners (Universities, Research Centers, and Companies) for the implementation of 3.500 Research and Technological Development RTD Projects. 1.340 members of the teaching and research staff, 12.000 external co-operators as well as a large number of postgraduate students have participated in these projects. The overall budget of these projects has risen up to 150 million Euros.

In the field of criminal justice, **the Department of Criminal Law and Criminology of School of Law of AUTH** has been implementing European and national programmes on criminal justice matters since 1987. Apart from action programmes, the department is also involved in research focusing on investigating the needs of juvenile offenders, their living conditions, their professional preferences and all other aspects which could help gain a better understanding of the target group and thus facilitate its social integration. Scientific Activities:

She has studied German Law, jurisprudence and criminology at Hamburg University, Germany. She took her PHD at Justus Liebig University in Giessen, Germany. The subject of her thesis was on sanctions without deprivation of liberty in the former German Democratic Republic, a study that included a broad comparative part focusing on many European countries. From 1973 to 1976 she was co-editor of "Justiz und NS-Verbrechen", a publication of the German penal judgements between 1945 – 1966 with regard to National Socialist culpable homicide. After some years as

researcher, mainly for the Max Planck Institute for Foreign and International Penal Law in Freiburg im Breisgau, Germany she studied Dutch law at the Free University of Amsterdam where she graduated in 1981. After many years as Assistant Professor and later as Associate Professor as well in the department for Penal Law and Criminology as in the Department for Legal History, Private International and Comparative Private Law at Leiden University she was appointed at Groningen University in 2000 to join the staff of the newly founded Hanse Law School and to teach German Law. Since 2007 Irene Sagel-Grande is primarily working on mainly empiric research projects in the field of European Sanction Systems, Prison Rules, The European Arrest Warrant, Comparative Penal Law, Insecurities in European Cities and Quality of Life in European Cities. Participated through the years in several EU projects and attended as speaker many conferences on comparative law and criminology, organised Leyden Law Courses in Criminology and held lectures in Criminology, Comparative Private Law and German Law for foreign student at Leyden University. Since 2008 Irene Sagel-Grande was conducting the research project "Foreigners in Detention" commissioned by the Association EuroMoS (European Monitoring System), during which almost 500 detained foreigners were interviewed. Furthermore she participated in EU projects on "Early Release" and on "Insecurities in European Cities".
